Opis zgornjih slik: *The left-hand photo shows people in carnival costumes and masks in Venice. Carnival is celebrated in Venice (Benetke, Italija) before Lent (postni čas), usually in February. The right-hand photo shows women at Diwali, the Hindu festival (hindujski festival luči) that takes place in October or November every year and celebrates the triumph of light over darkness.*

(RSVP so je kratica iz francoskega izraza Répondez s'il vous plaît.)
- a fancy dress party – zabava v maskah/kostumih
- It's up to you.- Odločitev je tvoja/vaša.
- to come over – priti naokrog
- a barbecue – zabava s hrano z žara
- What a pity! – Kakšna škoda!
- to invite – povabiti
- an invitation – vabilo
- to look after – paziti na
- to look forward to (+ ing) – veseliti se, npr. I'm looking forward to coming.
